Take exit 35A to merge onto N Roan St/US-11e/US-19W 0.9 mi, Slight right at TN-34/US-11e/US-19W, Continue to follow TN-34/US-11e 12.4 mi
 Take the TN-394/County Hwy-390 exit toward Bluff City/Blountville 0.3 mi. Turn right at Bluff City Rd/TN-394 Continue to follow TN-394 2.1 mi
 Continue on Bristol Beltway/TN-345.4 mi, Turn left at TN-34/TN-421/US-421 Continue to follow TN-34/US-421 1.7 mi, Turn right at E Cedar St 0.7 mi

King College is pleased to announce that we will be offering men's and women's cycling as part of our athletics program beginning fall 2009. This program will be part of the National Collegiate Cycling Association (NCCA), an official association of USA Cycling.

The level of participation in recent years has taken the sport of cycling to new heights. This success can be attributed to a boom in grassroots initiatives like local races and collegiate cycling programs. Today, there are approximately 215 NCCA member collegiate cycling clubs with over 2,500 member athletes.

"We are excited about the possibilities this new offering holds for King College and the region," said Rob Littleton, vice president for student affairs. Collegiate National Championships are annually covered in detail in several national publications, and collegiate cycling is a major focus of the national governing body, USA Cycling. General Information: Governing all Races

Race Registration: Will begin at 9:30 AM. You may register until 15 minutes before the start of each race. MSG is a USAC sanctioned event. All racers must present a valid racing license. Unlicensed riders will be required to purchase a \$10.00 "one day license", and be placed in the CX 4 men or Women. All riders will be required to complete and sign a "standard athletes entry release form".

* Entry fee includes \$3 USAC insurance surcharge

* Entry fee includes \$1 per race TBRA surcharge

All races will begin rain or shine, *USAC* rules to govern all races *Riders must wear ANSI approved helmets. Bar ends must be removed from mountain bikes. No refunds of entry fees. Organizer reserves right to combine fields, fields with fewer than four riders may be combined or canceled. Protest period will be 15 minutes after results are posted.
